1.	Des	ign	You	ur	Mic

- Choose a catchy name for your open mic.
 - Ideas:
 - Theme-based (e.g., 'The Galloping Giggle Open Mic')
 - Named after yourself
- Decide on a consistent schedule.
 - Check for less occupied time slots.
 - o Ensure it's a time you can commit to each week.

2. Select Your Streaming Platform

- Research and choose a platform:
 - Google Meet
 - o Zoom
 - Jitsi.org

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4. Set Up a Home Page

- Create a dedicated home page with details about the open mic:
 - Timing
 - Sign-up process
 - Rules
 - Performance duration
 - Contact information
- Set up a dedicated email address for open mic queries.
- Choose a platform for the home page (e.g., Facebook).

5. Promote Your Mic

 - Record each show
 - Do not record
- Handle time limit issues:
 - Set clear guidelines for performance duration
 - Decide on penalties or actions for those who exceed their time.
