Tip 1: Prep Like a Pro

- Set reminders on your calendar so you don't forget

Tip 4: Bring the Professionalism

- Treat the virtual stage with the same gravitas as Comedy Central
- Respect fellow comics and avoid interrupting others
- Deliver A+ material whether you have 5 or 500 viewers

- Capture your set if allowed to study successes and improvement areas
- Never record fellow comics without consent - this can create legal issues

Tip 6: Reflect on Each Set

- Identify what worked, what didn't and how the audience responded
- Use insights to keep improving and progressing

Tip 7: Tech Check!

- Confirm strong internet, clear mic and bright lighting beforehand
- A tech fail could derail your gig, so test equipment thoroughly
